


FIGURE 1. NORMALIZED POWER DISSIPATION vs CASE TEMPERATURE




FIGURE 2. MAXIMUM CONTINUOUS DRAIN CURRENT vs CASE TEMPERATURE




FIGURE 3. NORMALIZED MAXIMUM TRANSIENT THERMAL IMPEDANCE




FIGURE 4. FORWARD BIAS SAFE OPERATING AREA





FIGURE 5. PEAK CURRENT CAPABILITY

FIGURE 6. UNCLAMPED INDUCTIVE SWITCHING CAPABILITY




FIGURE 7. SATURATION CHARACTERISTICS




FIGURE 8. TRANSFER CHARACTERISTICS




FIGURE 9. NORMALIZED DRAIN TO SOURCE ON RESISTANCE vs JUNCTION TEMPERATURE




FIGURE 10. NORMALIZED GATE THRESHOLD VOLTAGE vs JUNCTION TEMPERATURE




FIGURE 11. NORMALIZED DRAIN TO SOURCE BREAKDOWN VOLTAGE vs JUNCTION TEMPERATURE





FIGURE 12. CAPACITANCE vs DRAIN TO SOURCE VOLTAGE




FIGURE 14. UNCLAMPED ENERGY TEST CIRCUIT




FIGURE 15. UNCLAMPED ENERGY WAVEFORMS




FIGURE 16. GATE CHARGE TEST CIRCUIT




FIGURE 17. GATE CHARGE WAVEFORM




FIGURE 18. SWITCHING TIME TEST CIRCUIT




FIGURE 19. RESISTIVE SWITCHING WAVEFORMS
